Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What is Regina West Zone Indoor Soccer?

A. This league is a no-cut recreational soccer for ages three to eighteen. Teams are co-ed. We emphasize sportsmanship, skill development and most of all fun. Winning is not the priority.

Q. What neighbourhoods are in the West Zone?

A. Dieppe Place, McNab, Normanview West, Prairie View, Regent Park, Rosemont, Mount Royal, Sherwood McCarthy, Twin Lakes, Walsh Acres, Lakeridge and Garden Ridge

Q. Who runs this soccer league?

A. Since 1992 a group of dedicated parent volunteers has operated the league. There are now almost 700 players playing on more than 50 teams in eight age groups.

Q. How do I register my children?

A. Your best option is to register and pay online at www.reginaindoorsoccer.ca. Forms can also be downloaded from the website or picked up from the West Zone Board Office. An in person registration is held on Sept.18 at 10-30-12:00 at the North West Leisure Centre to fill the remaining player spots.

Q. What is the registration deadline?

A. Registration starts on Aug.23 and the deadline is Oct.1. We recommend that you register early. In 2009 all of the age groups filled. Late registrations may not be accepted.

Q. When and where do teams play?

A. It varies by age group

- Ages 3 to 4 play (Timbits League) Saturday morning at George Lee School
- Ages 5 to 6 play (Timbits League) Saturday afternoon at George Lee School
- Ages 7 to 8 play Saturday morning at Centennial School
- Ages 9 to 10 play Saturday afternoon at Centennial School
- Ages 11 to 12 play Sunday afternoon at Centennial School
- Ages 13 to 18 play Saturday at the University of Regina gyms.

Q. How many regular season games do teams play?

A. Teams play about 15 regular season games. Although rare, games can be cancelled if facilities are not available. Cancelled games are not rescheduled. Tournament games are extra!

Q. Who coaches the teams?

A. Parents act as coaches and assistant coaches. The younger age groups need more coaches per team.

Q. How much does it cost?

A. Soccer fees ranges from \$45.00 to \$100.00. All families must also have a valid 2010 community membership or purchase one for \$6.00.

Q. What is included in the soccer fees?

A. Soccer fees go to cover costs associated with equipment, security, registration, team jerseys, tournaments trophies and food, facility rental, and referees. Ages 3-12 also receive professional team photos. The league runs on a cost recovery basis and tries to maintain costs affordable so that all children can participate in recreational soccer.

Q. Can my child play in an older age group?

A. Yes. You can make that request. It is not recommended for the 4&U, 6&U and 8&U age groups.

Q. Which teams get referees?

A. The 4&U teams do not have referees. We ask parents/coaches to act as referees for this age group. All other teams will have referees at their games.

Q. What equipment does my child need?

A. Players must wear non-marking gym shoes and shin guards. The league provides team t-shirts or jerseys.

Q. Can my child be on the same team as their friends?

A. It is possible to make a player request. Please note that player requests are not always granted. Team coordinators must use other criteria first such as siblings, grouping players from the same school, male/female ratio, and age ratio before considering player requests.

Q. Is there a code of conduct?

A. Yes. It is on the website and applies to players, coaches, referees and parents.
